## School Staff

- Decide which loan box you would like to borrow
- Email Loan coordinator Helen Smith on <u>LoansBoxes@beaminstermuseum.co.uk</u> more information or to arrange collection of loan box
- Complete Loan agreement form from website
- Arrange collection with Helen Smith
- Bring form, £10 payment and £50 deposit made payable to Beaminster Museum when collecting the box
- A completed checklist will be in the box
- Enjoy using the box following the loan agreement guidelines
- At end of loan period check all items back in the box and complete checklist
- Arrange return of the box with Helen Smith
- At the museum
  - return the box with completed checklist
  - $\succ$  collect the deposit
  - complete the return section of the loan agreement form
- Decide on next box to borrow!
